Student must accumulate 20 credits and successfully complete the combination of courses listed above. These will meet the Granite City CUSD #9 graduation requirements as well as those of the Illinois State Board of Education.								
* Note: The class of 2007 & 2008 must have only two years of math to graduate. The state legislators and ISBE have changed the graduation requirements in math beginning with the class of 2009 to include 3 years of math.
