We are pleased to inform you that **Wilson Elementary School** will be implementing a new option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Option (CEO) for the School Year 2011-2012. This is a pilot program that we will be trying for the entire 2011-2012 School Year at Wilson Elementary School.

What does this mean for you and your children attending the school(s) identified above? Great news for you and your students! All enrolled students of Wilson Elementary School (only) are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at no charge to your household each day of the 2011-2012 school year. There is no need to complete an Application for Free and Reduced meals for any students attending Wilson Elementary School. Should you have children that will be attending other schools (such as Coolidge, High School, etc.), you would need to complete an Application for Free and Reduced meals to apply for Free/Reduced Benefits at any other Granite City Schools.
