Our offerings include options for accelerated courses, college- prep courses, and vocational courses.

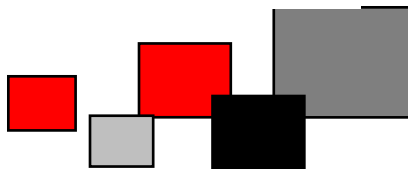
1. GCHS partners with St. Louis University through the SLU 1818 Advanced Credit Program.

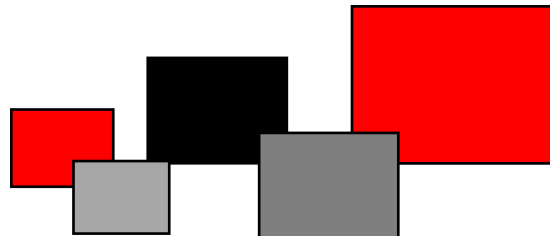
GCHS had 862 student dual credit registrations

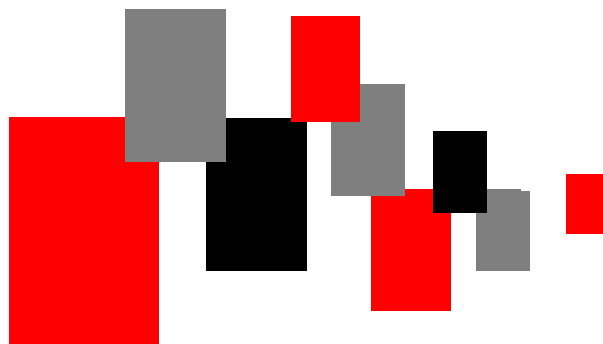

The Running Start Program is an off-campus dual-enrollment program which allows students to earn both their high school diploma and Associate's Degree while attending classes on the SWIC campus. Regular tuition and fee costs apply for students enrolled in the program.
